



## Notes for Applicants

1. Your application will be considered at the next meeting of the Club's management committee.
  2. It is not necessary to own a boat to join the Club. Members willing to crew are always welcome and the Club has a fleet of dinghies which are available for members to hire. Training courses at all levels are run according to demand.
  3. All sailing/windsurfing members are expected to undertake safety boat training (which first requires power boat level 2 (PB2) qualification) and to attend as rescue officer when required (Normally one day per season). You will always be partnered by an experienced person. Full members who do not wish to sail will be asked to do Catering Officer duty as an alternative.
  4. Family membership comprises 2 co-resident adults plus any children under 18 at 1<sup>st</sup> January or remaining in full time education. Both adults are full members with voting rights.
  5. Adult and partnership membership comprises 2 co-resident adults, both with voting rights
  6. The adult annual membership is reduced to the amount of a junior or student membership and the entrance fee is waived if the applicant is in full time education. A Junior member is a person who at 1<sup>st</sup> January is 13 years of age but under 18 years of age and a Student is a person in full time education. They have no voting rights but may be members in their own right or as part of a Family membership.
  7. Cadet members are children under the age of 13 and have no voting rights. Their membership must be as part of a family or they must have a parent or guardian who is applying for Adult or Beach membership. Please note that **all** Juniors and Cadets under the age of sixteen must be under adult supervision when on the water.
  8. Beach membership is intended for members who are no longer active sailors but who wish to remain associated with the Club as non voting members, or for the parents of Cadets who do not wish to sail themselves. Other persons may be accepted into this limited class of membership at the discretion of the committee. Membership includes husband and wife.
  9. A boat fee is payable for each boat kept at the Club. Topper or Board fees are applicable where they are kept on a rack. Owing to space limitations both on and off the water, preferred classes at Loch Venachar Sailing will be monohull craft only
  10. The board fee is waived where a full boat fee has been paid.
- N.B. Parents and guardians are warned that the Club is only able to provide Safety facilities during the hours of Club racing. Outside these hours parents and guardians have sole responsibility for their children and wards and must appreciate that the Club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control.***
